

The County Archives would welcome students from John Carroll for student internships. Projects available would include organizing and arranging historical records series, initiatives involving scanning of documents for purposes of preservation and greater access, and the preparation of responses to requests for information by researching our holdings. The records date from 1810 to the present, and are a valuable source regarding the history of Cleveland and Cuyahoga County. Internships are available throughout the year, but often are tied to a college or university's academic calendar, e.g. Fall, Spring, Summer, etc. Access to the Archives would be available for students from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m., Monday through Friday.
