

John Carroll University Class of 2019 At Graduation Survey Preliminary Report

The Class of 2019 At Graduation Survey Preliminary Report is based on the information collected via survey at the May 2019 Commencement ceremonies and data collected from the Office of the Registrar. Participants included graduates from January, May, and August of 2019. The report provides information about employment and graduate/professional school status of the graduates. The undergraduate and graduate survey response rate was 81% and 51.1%, respectively.

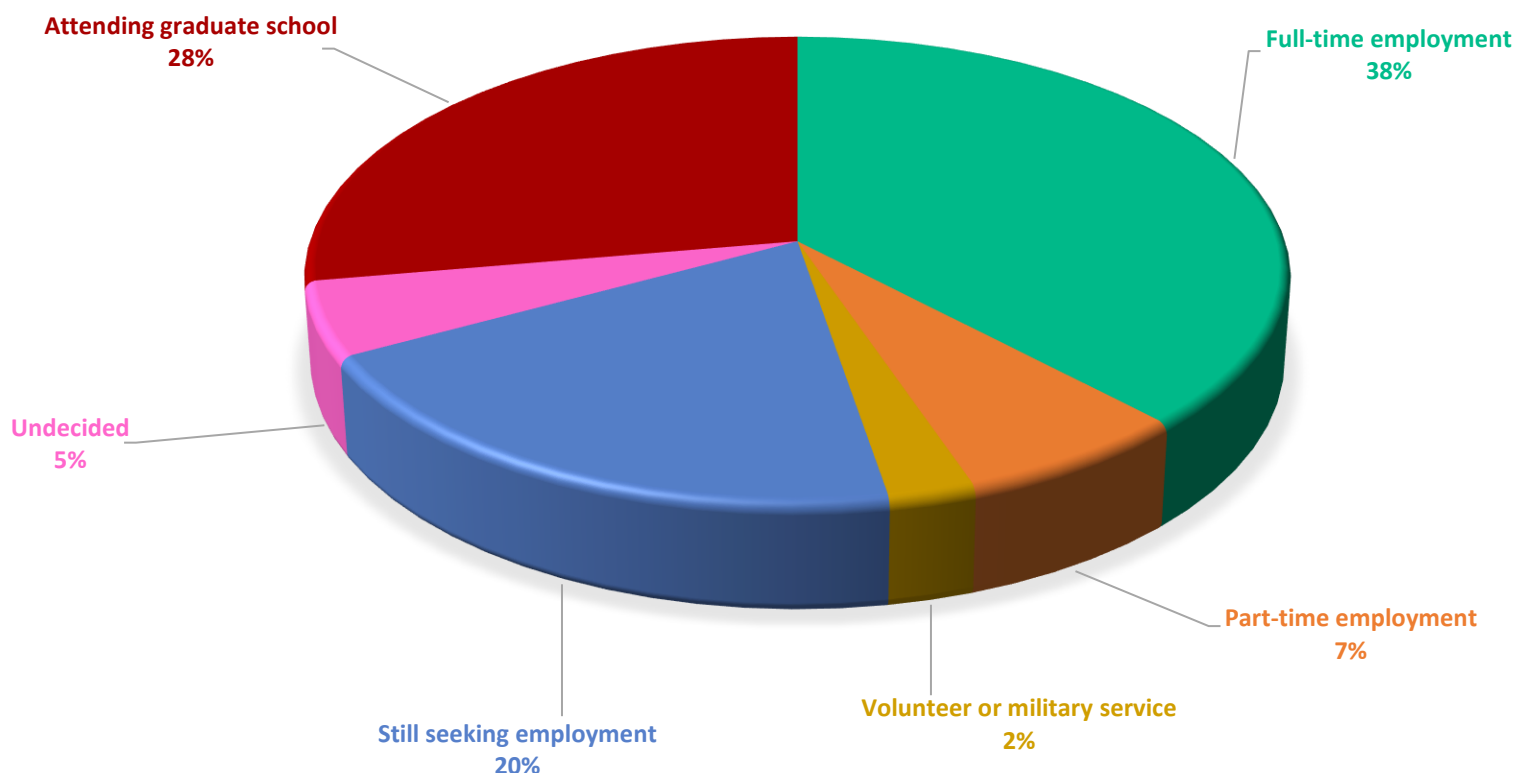
Undergraduate Outcome Highlights

Of the 581 undergraduates who responded to the survey:

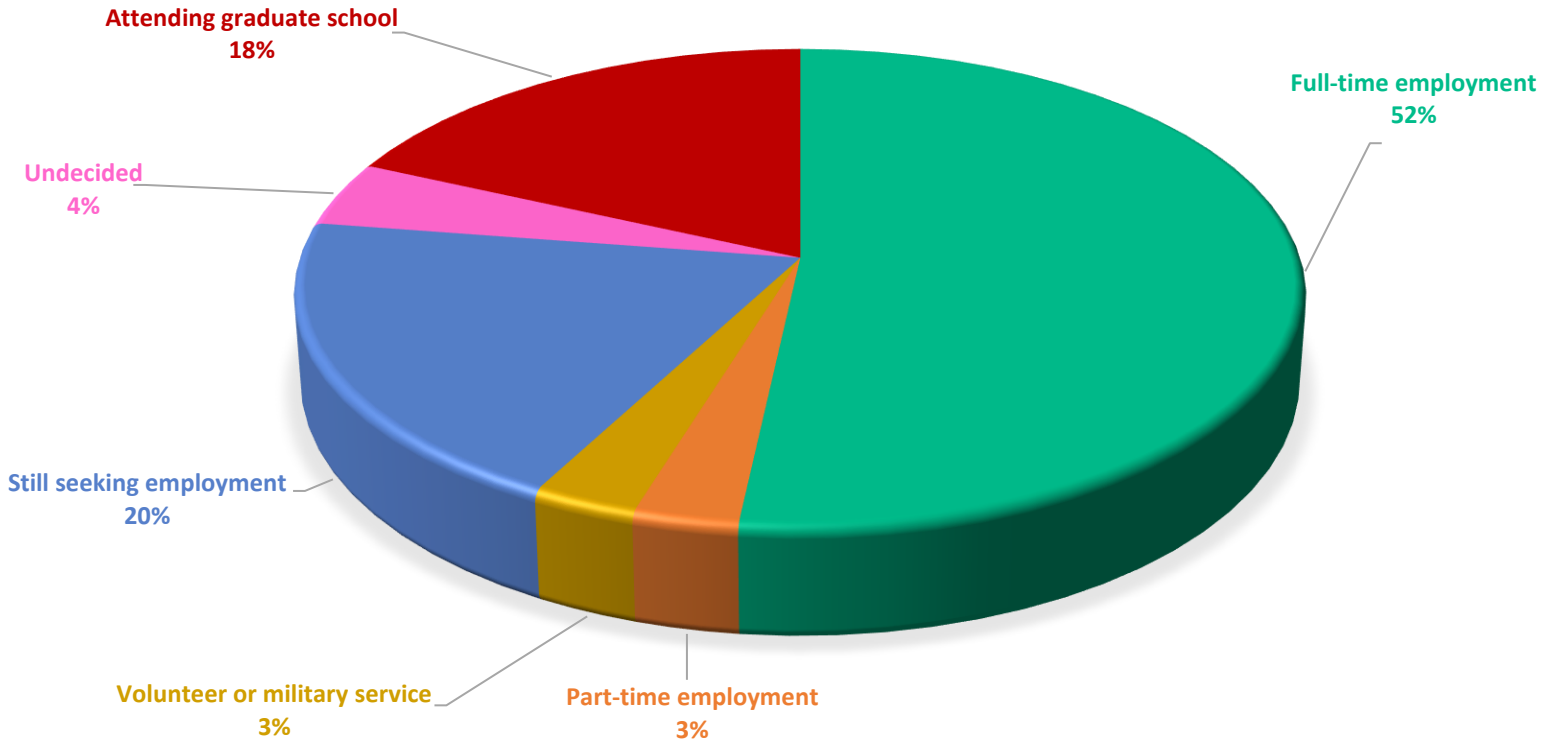
- 68.2% (n = 396) of the 581 undergraduate respondents have accepted a full-time position, are attending graduate school or are committed to volunteer or military service.
- 73.0% (n = 168) of the 230 undergraduate respondents from the Boler College of Business have accepted a full-time position, are attending graduate school or are committed to volunteer or military service.
- 65.0% (n = 228) of the 351 undergraduate respondents from the College of Arts & Sciences have accepted a full-time position, are attending graduate school, or are committed to volunteer or military service.

Post-Graduation Status of Undergraduates

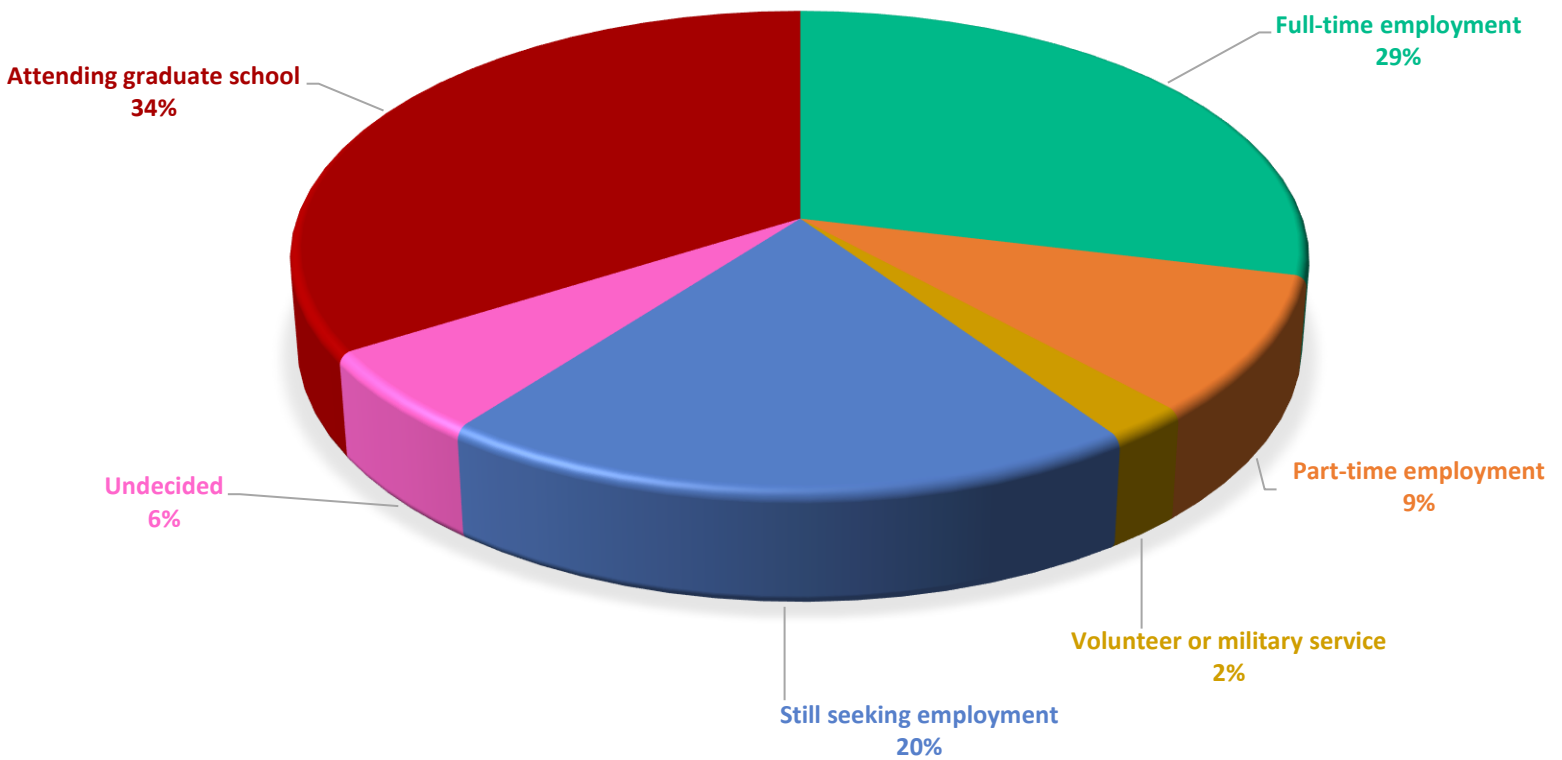

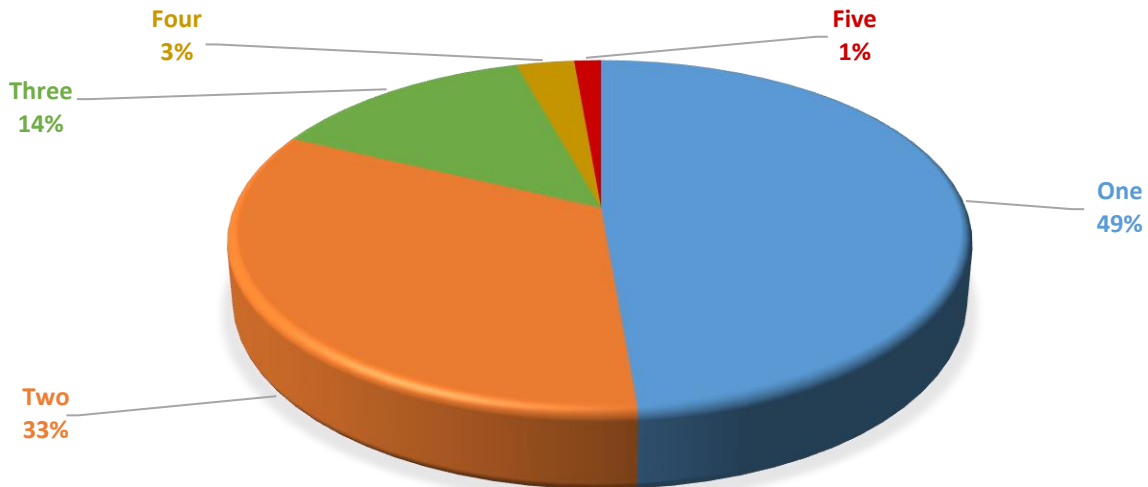


Internships/Research Experiences of Undergraduate Students Highlights

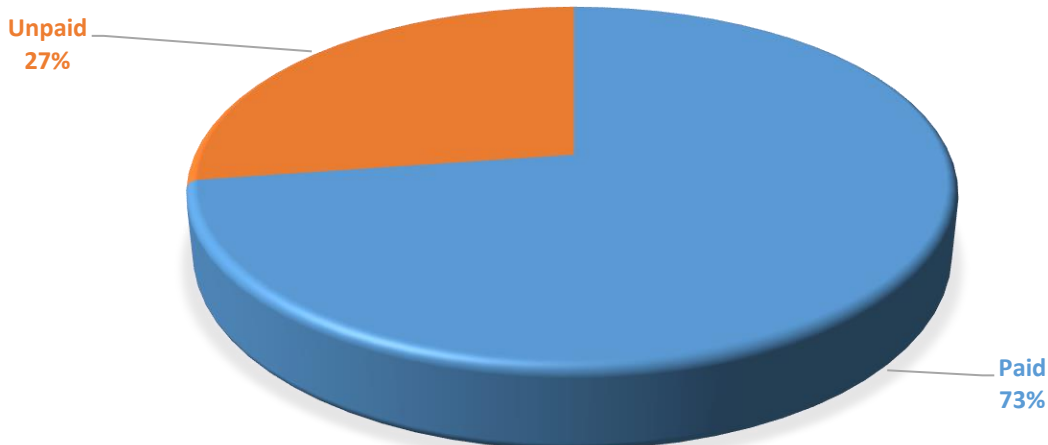
Of the 581 undergraduates who responded to the survey:

- 76.1% (n = 442) of the 581 undergraduate respondents completed at least one internship or research experience.
- 90.0% (n = 207) of the 230 undergraduate respondents from the Boler College of Business completed at least one internship or research experience.
- 67.0% (n = 235) of the 351 undergraduate respondents from the College of Arts & Sciences completed at least one internship or research experience.
- Of the 442 undergraduates who completed an internship or research experience, 51.4% (n = 227) completed two or more.

Experiences that were Paid/Unpaid**

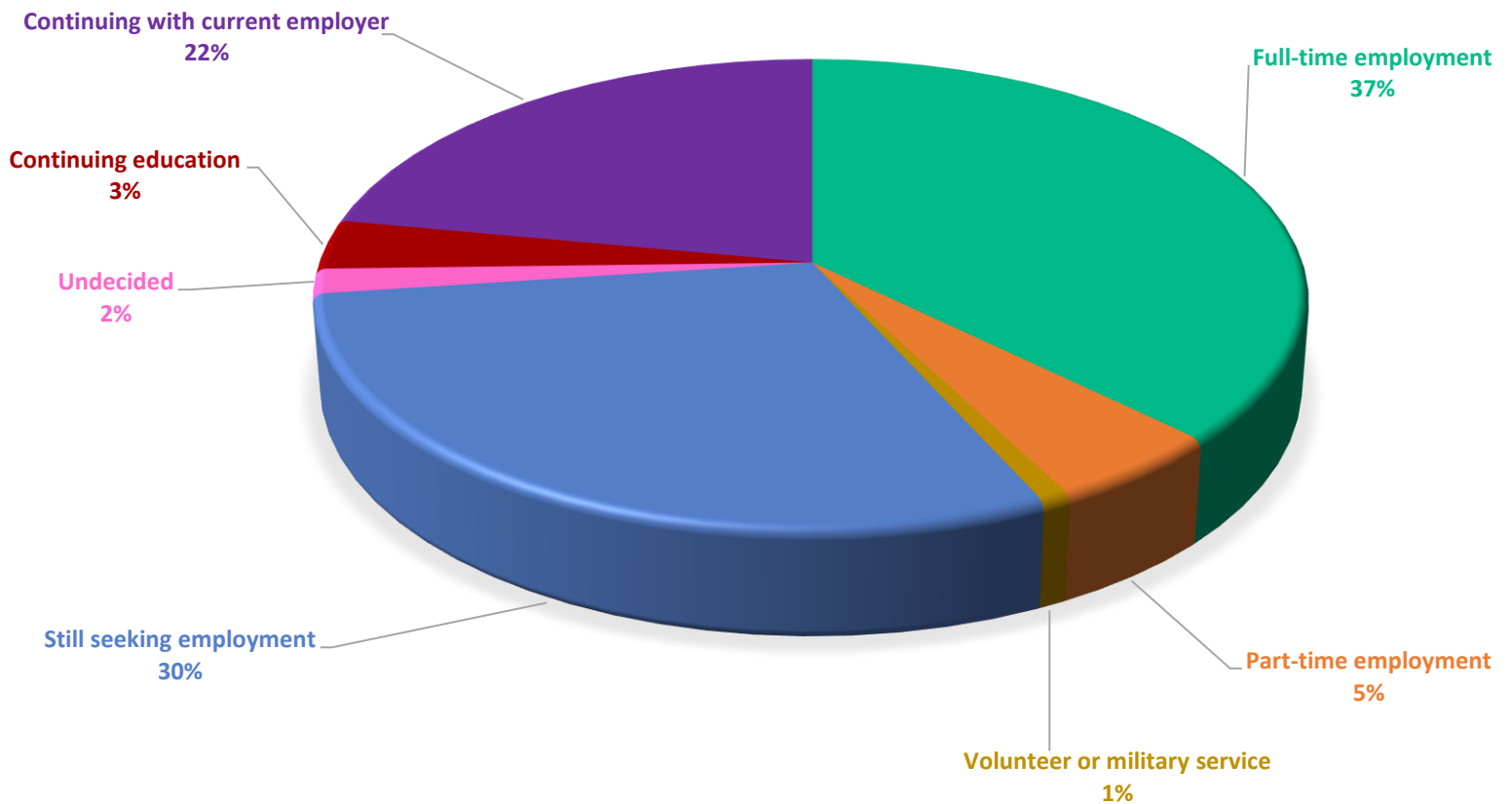


Graduate Student Outcome Highlights

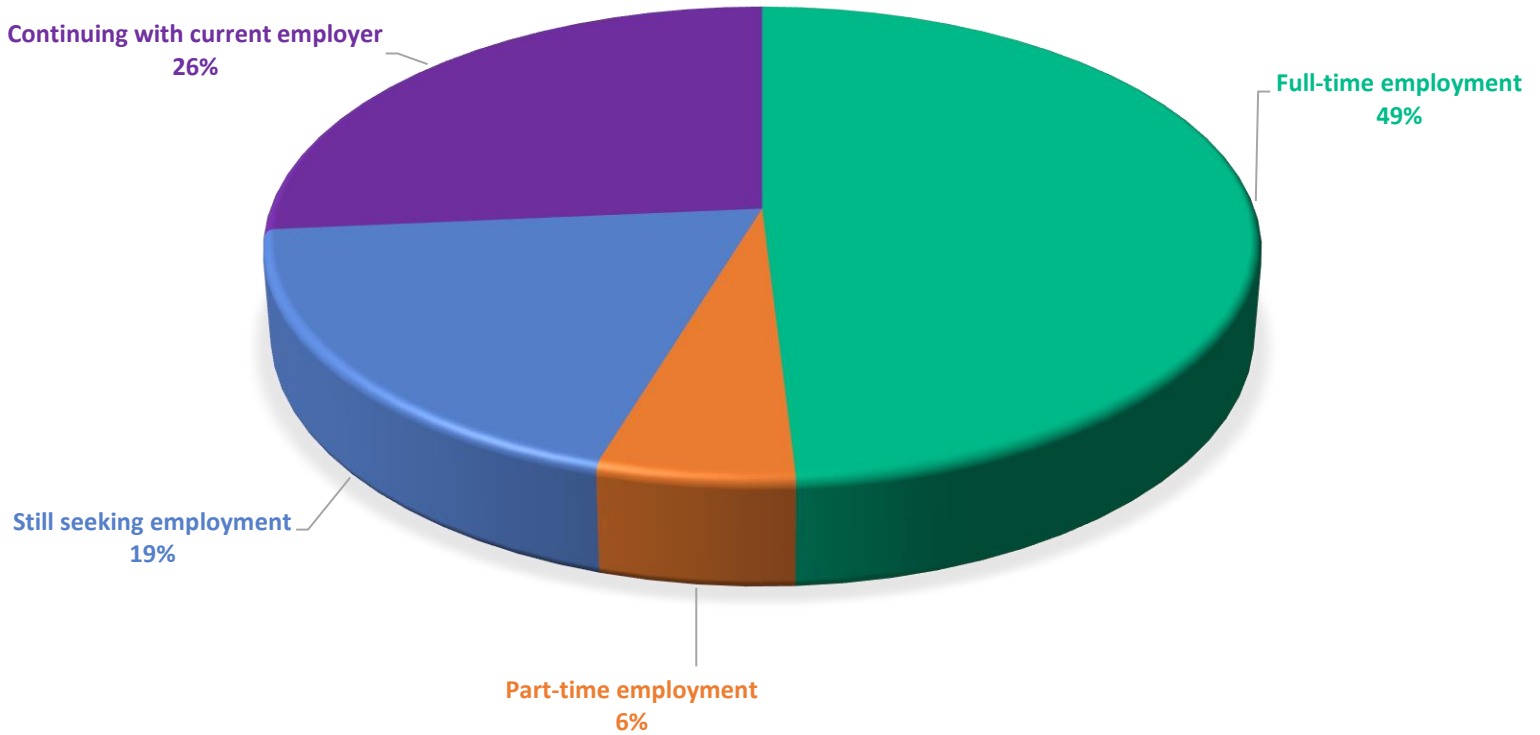
Of the 118 Graduate Students who responded to the survey:

- 62.7% (n = 74) of the 118 graduate student respondents have accepted a full-time position with a new employer, are remaining with their current employer or are continuing their education.
- 75.5% (n = 40) of the 53 graduate student respondents from the Boler College of Business respondents have accepted a full-time position with a new employer or are remaining with their current employer.
- 52.3% (n = 34) of the 65 graduate student respondents from the College of Arts & Sciences respondents have accepted a full-time position with a new employer, are remaining with their current employer or are continuing their education.

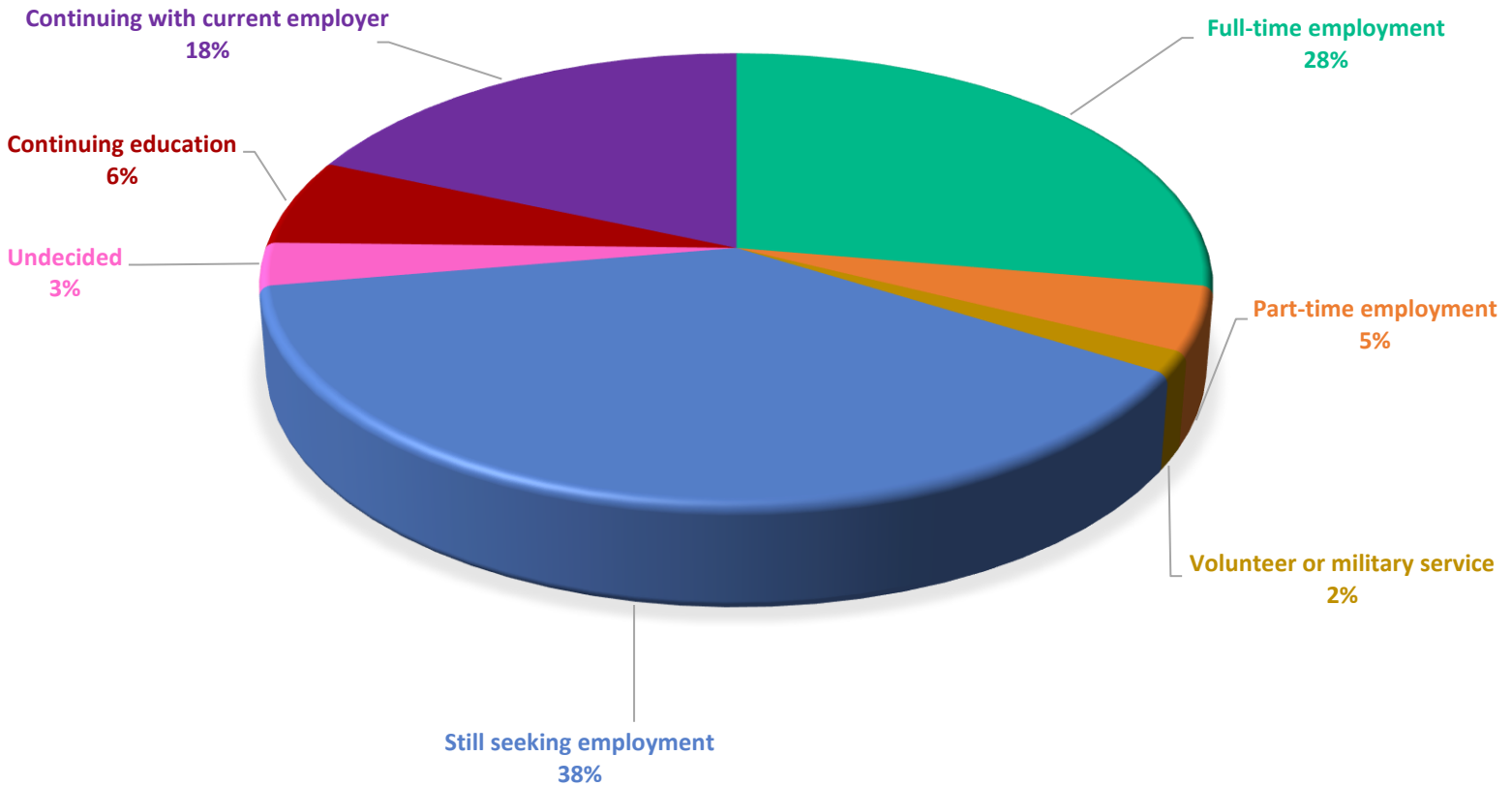

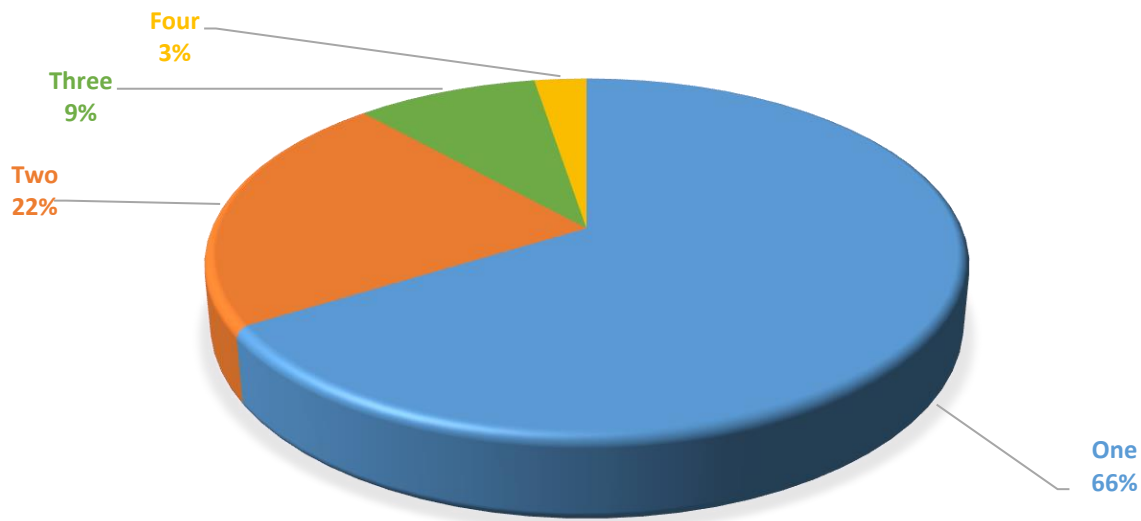


Internship, Practicums and Research Experiences of Graduate Students Highlights

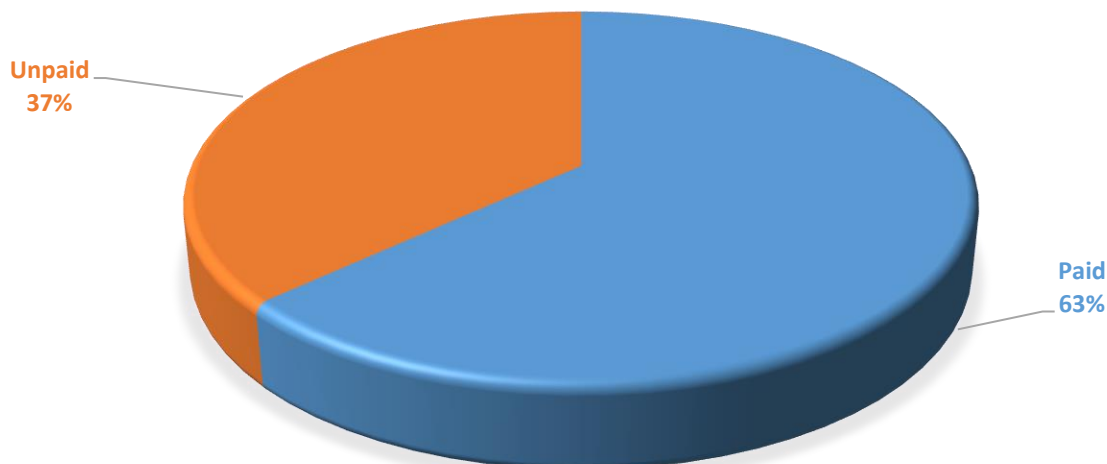
Of the 118 graduate students who responded to the survey:

- 65.3% (n = 77) of the 118 graduate student respondents completed at least one internship, practicum or research experience.
- 62.3% (n = 33) of the 53 graduate student respondents from the Boler College of Business completed an internship, practicum or research experience.
- 67.7% (n = 44) of the 65 graduate student respondents from the College of Arts & Sciences completed an internship, practicums or research experience.
- Of the 77 graduate students who completed an internship, practicum or research experience, 33.8% (n = 26) completed two or more.
