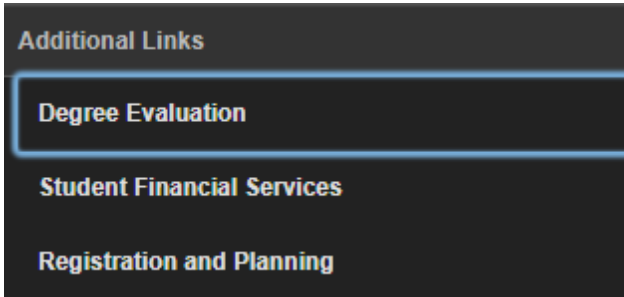


Running Your Degree Evaluation

After logging into your Student Profile at <https://banner.jcu.edu/>, click on **Degree Evaluation** under Additional Links on the lower left side of the screen under your picture.



A new tab will load and display your CURRENT curriculum information for your review. If the curriculum information listed is incorrect, use the appropriate Application or Request links on the Registrar's website at <https://jcu.edu/registrar/services-and-forms> to change your major, minor, concentration, etc.

This page is also where you will begin to generate your degree evaluation. If your curriculum information is correct, choose **Generate New Evaluation** at the bottom of the page. **You should *always* generate a new evaluation to see your most updated record.**

1. At the bottom of the page, click "Generate New Evaluation" **
2. Select the program and under "Select a Term," select the term you entered JCU
3. Click "Generate Request"
4. Select "Detail Requirements" and submit (Printer Friendly, if you plan to print it)

**If you are not officially admitted to your major, you will need to go to "What-if Analysis" and enter your intended major to run a Degree Evaluation. You will be asked to enter both your "Entry Term" (the term you entered JCU) and your "Evaluation Term" (the current semester).

Reading Your Degree Evaluation

Your degree evaluation first gives you information about your total credit hours and cumulative (aka overall) GPA.

The **Total Required** is the minimum number of credit hours you must earn for your degree. Distributive (old) core students must complete at least 128 credit hours to earn their degree and Integrative (new) core students must complete at least 120 credit hours to earn their degree. **The Used hours in the Total Required row includes all of the credits that you have completed, transferred in, and are currently registered for.**

The next line, **Last Number Institutional Required**, refers to the graduation requirement that at least 60 semester hours must be completed in residence at JCU.

The next lines show your cumulative/overall **GPA**. All students must earn a 2.0 or higher cumulative GPA to graduate.
