Middle Childhood Four Year Plans (revised FA 2019)

Notes to Consider When Referring to Middle Childhood Four-Year Plans

1. MCE licensure requires that candidates complete course work in two content areas (choose from: math, science, language arts, and social studies). Suggested four year plans for each of the combinations of content are outlined below.
2. These four year plans for each of the concentrations are **suggested** plans and can be modified in consultation with your advisor.
3. Courses that are **BOLDED** should be taken in the semester in which the course is placed. This is due to pre-requisites, co-requisites, and when the course is scheduled to be offered. Similarly, courses that are listed in a specific semester are typically only offered in that semester.
4. The four plans include EN 125. For those students who take EN 120/121, the first year schedule will need to be modified to accommodate this.
5. The four plans include two semesters of a foreign language. For those students who will take more or fewer semesters, the schedule will need to be modified in consultation with the advisor.
6. In all of the subject areas, there are licensure requirements that fulfill specific core requirements (i.e. PO 101 fulfills the Social Science Experience in the Distributive Requirements) This is indicated in the plan with a / (i.e. EN 277/Humanities Experience).
7. Education courses and content area courses are completed prior to student teaching. While not recommended, students may take one additional course during the student teaching semester.
