Friends of Euclid Creek Announces 2020 Environmental Studies Scholarship

South Euclid, OH, Feb. 25, 2020 - The Friends of Euclid Creek (FOEC), a grassroots, non-profit organization advocating for the health of the Euclid Creek watershed, is pleased to announce the availability of its 2020 annual scholarship in environmental studies. This scholarship aids one deserving student in his/her pursuit of a degree or certificate in environmental studies, field biology, or any scientific field related to watershed health.

FOEC is currently seeking applications from high school seniors or college students who are interested in studying within the field of environmental science. The one thousand dollar (\$1,000.00) scholarship - earmarked for educational purposes – will be awarded on June 2 at the Friends of Euclid Creek Annual Meeting and picnic. There may be a second scholarship of five hundred dollars (\$500.00). The Friends of Euclid Creek Board of Directors approve all awards.

Applicants must not have received a previous scholarship from the Friends of Euclid Creek. FOEC prefers, but does not require, applicants who live or have gone to school in the Euclid Creek Watershed area. Applicant evaluation is based on background and potential to contribute to environmental studies or a related field.

Interested students must submit a one to two-page letter describing their career goals, past volunteer work related to environmental studies, and significant achievements to date. Applicants also must provide a minimum of one letter of recommendation from a teacher, counselor or community member.

All application materials must be postmarked on or before April 1, 2020. Mail applications to the Friends of Euclid Creek, P.O. Box 21384, South Euclid, Ohio 44121. Emailing applications requires prior permission. Applicants must also be willing to complete an interview with FOEC members, upon request, and release information and photos about winning the scholarship.
