AT JCU WITH SCHOLARSHIP SUPPORT

Awards of up to \$4,000 per year

Students transferring to John Carroll University to pursue STEM-related majors are invited to apply for the Molding Identity & Raising Retention through Opportunities for Reflection In STEM (MIRRORS) scholarship. These scholarships, funded by the National Science Foundation's Scholarships in Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics (S-STEM) program, will provide up to \$4,000 per year to incoming transfer students with demonstrated financial need and academic promise to succeed in STEM disciplines at JCU. Scholarships are renewable for students who continue to meet eligibility requirements.

To receive priority consideration for this scholarship, you must apply by June 1, 2020.

Applicants must have a minimum 3.0 college GPA, have sufficient coursework to graduate in two years, and be intending to major in:

- Biology
- Cell and Molecular Biology
- Chemistry
- Computer Science
- Data Science
- Engineering Physics
- Environmental Science
- Mathematics
- Physics

Program benefits include:

- Academic support, including participating in STEM-specific orientation activities, a summer bridge program, and curricula introducing scientific thinking and research
- Competitive summer research fellowships and funds to support travel to scientific meetings
