



2020 - 2021 Cost of Education

The Office of Financial Aid's ability to meet your financial need is influenced by government student aid policies at the federal and state level and the total amount of funds we have available for aid each year, and the sum of all JCU students' estimated financial needs. Your financial aid award is based on the following general formula:

$$\text{Cost of Education} - \text{Family Contribution} = \text{Estimated Financial Need}$$

Your family contribution is determined by the U.S. Department of Education from the information you provided on the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). The amount of financial aid awarded is in part determined by the total cost of education.

GRADUATE EDUCATION PROGRAMS

Full-Time

Full-time tuition is based on an average of 19 credit hours.

Part-Time

Part-time tuition is based on an average of 10 credit hours.

This budget represents AVERAGE cost of attendance. Students are billed for the ACTUAL hours registered.
