

Required Curriculum for Leadership Scholars*

GENERAL LEADERSHIP COURSES (6 credits)

LP 101 (1 credit) – Intro to Leadership and LP 102 (1 credit) – Approaches to Leadership

- Automatically registered in these courses for fall of first year

LP 304 (1 credit) – Strategic Decisions

- Online course that involves shadowing a leader in your professional field

LP 401 (1 credit in fall) and LP 402/403 (2 credits in spring)

- 3-credit capstone sequence taken senior year (or junior year for some)

CLASSES THAT ALSO FULFILL THE JCU CORE OR A MAJOR REQUIREMENT (15 credits)

LP 135 (3 credits) - Leadership & Social Justice

- Fulfills Issues of Social Justice requirement in core

LP 250 (3 credits) – Global Leadership

- Fulfills Engaging the Global Community requirement in core

COMM 125H (3 credits) – Speech Communication

- Taken as a cohort and fulfills oral expression requirement in core

****Designated ethics course (3 credits)**

- Usually counts either for your major or for one of your core philosophy courses

****Designated communication class (3 credits)**

- Fulfills humanities requirement in core or is part of a linked-pair core requirement

Minimum Acceptable Progress for Leadership Development Minor to remain in good standing for the Leadership Scholars

At the end of freshman year: 5 credits completed (LP 101/102, LP 135)

At the end of sophomore year: 8 credits completed

At the end of junior year: 12 credits completed

Senior year: Must be enrolled in LP 401 in fall semester (if not yet completed in prior semester) and have a plan in place for completing the minor during your senior year
