The model identifies three key components of Jesuit teaching and learning: (a) drawing on **experience**, (b) **reflecting** on that experience, and (c) the **action** that follows from learning. 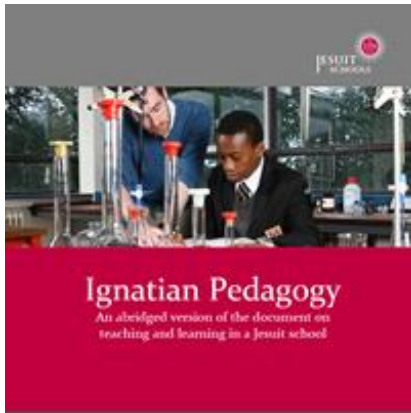
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Ignatian Pedagogy - A Practical Approach
