CARROLL

- ⇒ A federally-funded literacy tutoring program, modeled after the America Reads national grassroots tutoring program
- Builds and refines reading skills for children in elementary grades
- ⇒ Partners include local Cleveland private and public schools
- ⇒ Tutors are paid \$8.70/hour for tutoring twice/week, or approximately five hours each week
- ⇒ Tutors must qualify for **Federal Work Study** to be paid





GET INVOLVED WITH CARROLL READS!

- Look on Handshake or email carrollreads@jcu.edu to apply each semester, and check Federal Work Study eligibility (required to be paid for service)
- Meet with Carroll Reads Coordinator for informal interview to determine eligibility and check availability
- Commit to tutoring two days per week, for ten weeks, over the course of a semester
- Complete an initial training that includes basic tutoring strategies, early childhood pedagogical best practices, cultural competency, and information on specific populations served
- 5. Receive continuous **training** throughout the semester
