

# ***SECURITY ALERT***

## **John Carroll University Campus Safety Services**

**Type of Incident:** Indecent Exposure

**Location of Incident:** Miramar Boulevard near Washington Boulevard

**Date of Incident:** Monday 9/9/2013

**Time of Incident:** Approximately 1:00 p.m.

**Incident Description:** A student was jogging southbound along Miramar Boulevard on the west sidewalk when she noticed a man on the sidewalk in front of her. As she approached him, he stepped off the sidewalk and exposed himself to the student. The student then ran toward campus to get away from the man.

**Description of Suspect(s):** The student described the suspect as: A white male, 35 to 45 years old, brown greying hair that was fairly long. He was wearing a baggy blue polo shirt with a white company logo printed on it, a yellow lanyard and khaki pants.

**Additional Information:** The student reported this to the John Carroll Police at 1:45pm. John Carroll Police notified the University Heights Police and both departments searched the area for the suspect. A couple people were stopped and questioned, but a suspect was not identified.

- Don't allow "tailgaters" to enter secured doors behind you, especially in the residence halls.
- Let a responsible person know where you are going, when you will return and how to contact you if you go somewhere alone outside of your normal routine.
- Use the "buddy" system with people you trust to watch out for each other's safety if you go to a party, bar or nightclub. Don't walk alone after dark off campus.
- Trust your "gut" feelings and avoid persons and situations that make you feel uncomfortable
