Type of Incident(s): Theft from Offices

Date/Time of Incident(s): Monday, July 26th, at 11:23am.

Incident Description: On Monday, July 26th at 11:23am, a JCU staff member called JCUPD Dispatch and reported that after leaving her office and returning, she confronted a man in her office who was holding her wallet. The suspect ran out of the office and down the Administration Building hallway toward the O'Malley Center. Several staff members chased after him. The suspect exited O'Malley and ran toward Gesu Church. He then got into a light colored Kia Soul in the Gesu parking lot, and drove onto Conover Road toward Warrensville Center Road.

The office that the suspect entered is in the lower level of the Administration Building.

Description of Suspect(s): A photo of the suspect is attached. He was described as a male, approximately 6' tall, wearing a light grey T-shirt, white shorts, light rimmed glasses, and black facemask with white print.

Additional Information: No one was injured or threatened during this incident, and no weapon was seen or indicated.

It is unknown if the suspect entered other offices or stole items from elsewhere on campus. Please check your office and belongings and contact JCUPD if anything is missing.

* The victim's wallet was found, missing a small amount of cash.

- Don't allow "tailgaters" to enter secured doors behind you, especially in the residence halls.
- Let a responsible person know where you are going, when you will return and how to contact you if you go somewhere alone outside of your normal routine.
- Use the "buddy" system with people you trust to watch out for each other's safety if you go to a party, bar or nightclub. Don't walk alone after dark off campus.
- Trust your "gut" feelings and avoid persons and situations that make you feel uncomfortable
