## TAKE THE NEXT STEP

### **PATHWAY TO LICENSURE**

■ Through successful completion of your JCU Counseling degree and a passing score on the Ohio licensure exam, graduating students complete the academic requirements for an initial license as a Licensed Professional Counselor, or a Licensed Professional School Counselor. Typically after a period of supervised work post-graduation, you'll be independently licensed and able to diagnose and treat mental and emotional disorders without supervision. Depending on the state where you will practice as a counselor, there may be additional post graduation requirements you need to fulfill. John Carroll staff are available to support students from enrollment to graduation to licensure.

#### **COST AND FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE**

- The tuition for the 2024-2025 academic year is \$875 per credit.
- A limited number of graduate assistantships provide a tuition waiver for up to 15 credit hours per year plus a stipend. Graduate assistants are expected to spend 20 hours per week working in a department on campus.
- The University's Student Enrollment and Financial Services offers assistance with student loans.
- Great Minds Fellowship Partner Institution Up to \$10,000 Fellowship available to Clinical Mental Health Counseling internship students (2<sup>nd</sup> year of study) who commit to interning and later working in a Community Behavioral Health Center (CBHC) in Ohio.
