**Direct Expenses are the actual charges for the year that are billed to you, including tuition, fees, and housing and meals (if living on campus). As defined by federal regulations, all institutions of higher learning must create a total Cost of Education that includes variable expenses not directly billed to you as the student. The expanded total Cost of Education gives you the opportunity to borrow to cover expenses you may incur as a college student. New students will also be charged an orientation fee on their first bill.*

*** This budget is based on the average tuition cost for an undergraduate student attending part-time. Students will be billed for the actual hours registered.*

****Loan fees are estimated and included for those students who borrow Federal Direct Stafford loans. They are not charged by JCU.*

[^]Food allowance that equates, with meal plan, to three meals a day for on-campus students and is reflective of median housing costs. Not charged by JCU

Students who are required by law to obtain a state license at the end of their degree program will have a licensure allowance added to their cost of attendance in their final year.

Students registered for less than 12 credit hours per semester will be assessed at a per credit hour rate of \$1,725 and in most cases financial aid will be adjusted accordingly. The Undergraduate Summer 2025 rate per credit hour is \$860

Please note that the amount of financial aid awarded cannot exceed the total cost of education.
